

LaMotte Elementary District
Senate Bill 307 Resolution of Intent to Increase Permissive Fund Levies
March 2017

The Board of Trustees of LaMotte Elementary District hereby resolves to consider and adopt the following changes in revenues/mills from Adult Education, Transportation, Tuition, Bus Depreciation, and Building Reserve Funds of the Elementary School District for school fiscal year 2018.


Be it further resolved, that as an essential part of its budgeting process, the LaMotte School District Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The LaMotte School District Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the District:

Whereas the Board of Trustees have determined that improvements above and beyond the current voted building reserve fund levy are needed to the school facility that include increased energy efficiency (windows, doors, digital controls), technology enhancements (cabling, smart boards, video), school safety (cameras, locks, blinds), and the replacement of flooring, and future roof repairs.

Impacts above are based on current year 2016-17 certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year.

Be it resolved that the LaMotte Elementary School District Board of Trustees approves the resolution of intent to increase permissive fund levies as presented above for the school fiscal year 2017-18.
